What does disability mean?

A disability occurs when a person with certain deficiencies interacts with the existent barriers within his physical, social and behavioral environment. We can refer to physical and locomotor, sensorial (visual, auditive), mental (cognitive, neurological or psychological) disabilities.

Why is the inclusion of persons with disabilities so important?

Because the minority consisting of persons with disabilities is the largest worldwide. Anyone, no matter the gender, age, ethnicity or religion can have or develop a disability. **We are different but we have the same rights!**

Inclusion of persons with disabilities can be discouraged by barriers such as discrimination, social phobia, or labels. It is important that everyone makes efforts in order to mitigate these barriers and to create an inclusive and accessible environment for all.

The Exclusion of Social Barriers

Persons with disabilities have the right to be treated normally. Everyone is unique and functions differently, whether they have a disability or not. Some disabilities are obvious (such as physical or locomotor), but others might be hidden (such as auditory or mental).

Here are several suggestions for an effective communication with persons with disabilities:

- Focus on the person, not on the disability
- Address the person directly, ask clarifying questions instead of making suppositions
- Offer your help and wait for the other's acceptance
- Respect the other's personal space and needs

Formal declaration of a disability

This is an important step towards obtaining access to a series of resources necessary for the improvement of life and work quality. Such resources might be:

- Accessibility of workplace and tasks adaption according to the functional potential
- Exemptions from certain taxes and social security contributions
- Reductions or exemptions from certain tax payment
- Credits with subsidized loans
- Right to park on reserved lots

In order to submit the application for disability assessment and classification, it is needed:

- Standard application form
- Medical files:
 - Report filled by the specialist doctor
 - Standard medical letter from the family doctor
- Paraclinical investigations required by the psycho-medico-social criteria in force for the considered pathology
- Copy of the identity document
- Certificate which attests the employment
- Social investigation at home, performed by the specialized social service
